Call for 2022 FMEC Annual Meeting Submissions is Open

DAYTON, OHIO – The Family Medicine Education Consortium (FMEC) is seeking program and poster submissions for its 2022 Annual Meeting, to be held September 16-18, 2022, at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City in Arlington, VA. The deadline for educational program submissions is February 11, 2022. The deadline for medical student poster submissions is July 1, 2022.

Every year, the FMEC hosts a lively and innovative Annual Meeting, rotating through states in the northeastern U.S., for medical students, family medicine residents, faculty and others involved in family medicine. Attendees participate in peer-reviewed scholarly sessions, hands-on workshops and a popular residency program recruitment fair. Through a robust scholarship initiative, the FMEC brings hundreds of medical students to the Annual Meeting to consider family medicine for their careers and to meet with residency programs around the country. The Annual Meeting is also the forum for the FMEC to recognize excellence in family medicine and primary care through its many award programs. At the recent 2021 Annual Meeting held October 8-10, 2021, in Pittsburgh, PA, over 260 faculty members, 174 residents, and 237 medical students attended The Residency Fair featured nearly 70 residency program booths and was as lively and loud as ever. The program featured over 170 workshops, seminars, research presentations, discussions and more and nearly 100 posters.

The FMEC invites family physicians, residents and medical students throughout the northeastern U.S. to submit presentations. The meeting will be held at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City, which is easily accessible from DC-area airports and only a short Metro ride to all of Washington's exciting attractions. Formats range from 5 minutes to 2 hours. Submissions are vetted through a peer-review process, and acceptance decisions are based on the overall quality of the submission and appropriateness of the topic for our conference.
