New To The Meeting?

Here are some tips!

Description of Presentation Formats

Workshops (1 hour)

Workshops are designed to transmit specific skills and are directed toward learning methodologies and strategies for approaching problems in teaching students, residents and faculty. The participants should be actively involved and should be able to acquire an understanding of various approaches to these problems.

Seminars (1 hour)

Seminars are designed to transmit specific knowledge in a given area and consist of a combination of formal presentations and group discussions.

Research and Quality Improvement (30 minutes each – or 2 per 1-hour block)

These presentations report rigorously-designed investigations or quality improvement activities and are followed by a moderated discussion.

Paper Presentations

(15 minutes each – or 4 per 1-hour block)

Paper presentations provide an opportunity to present to a wide audience about research, scholarship, curricular design, teaching programs, community service, and any other topic of interest related to family medicine. Both completed projects and those under development may be presented.

Lecture Discussions

(20 minutes each – or 3 per 1-hour block)

The Lecture Discussion format involves a 20-minute presentation to share information that relates to a clinical, educational or policy topic, report of a project and/or activity, or introduction of a policy issue, along with time for participant discussion.

Posters (70 minutes per session)

Scientific posters are presented on various topics of interest in family medicine, with authors available for discussion.

Clinical Success Stories, Speed Presentations, Poster Speed Presentations (5-7 minutes each)

This format provides the presenter of a research or QI project, case study, or patient encounter with 5-7 minutes to share ideas and information in a focused, direct manner. They are typically grouped with up to 10 in an hour-long session.

Clinical Camp Tables (70 minutes per session)

This format is an opportunity to watch and participate in a hands-on demonstration of a clinical procedure commonly performed in family medicine, using patient models and materials.

Breakfast Discussion Tables (60 minutes)

Breakfast Discussion Tables are opportunities during the Saturday breakfast for scholarly and networking discussions. The title of the table is the topic, and presenters may provide brief opening remarks but generally facilitate discussion of the topic.

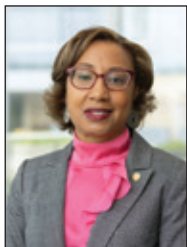

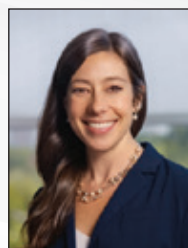

"Healthcare Communication in the Digital Era."

A doctor's ability to communicate evidence-based information to their patients is an essential pillar of good medicine. Unfortunately, physicians face an uphill battle these days due to the avalanche of misinformation patients receive on social media. While face-to-face communication is important, doctors are increasingly pressured to use social media themselves to debunk misinformation directly.

Doctor Mike Varshavski has built an audience of over 30 million followers doing just that: educating about health and science through organic posts on platforms like YouTube and Instagram. Unfortunately, he can't do it alone. Hear from the man himself about the do's and don'ts of educating online so that we can curb the misinformation pandemic together.

"Shaping the Future of Care: Where Leadership, Policy, and AI Converge."

Healthcare stands at a defining moment. AI is advancing at a pace few could have imagined, creating extraordinary opportunities to improve care, expand access, and empower patients. Yet the most important questions are not technological. They are human. Dr. Baston will explore what it means to lead through one of the most consequential transformations in modern medicine. This session will

examine the promise and challenges of AI in healthcare, the responsibilities that come with innovation, and the critical role physicians must play in shaping the future. As clinicians, we witness firsthand the realities of the healthcare system and the needs of the people it serves. Our voices are essential not only at the bedside, but at the tables where decisions are made. If we want policies that promote both innovation and access, protect patients, and improve outcomes, physicians must help lead the conversation. The discussion will also place healthcare's AI revolution within a broader global context. As artificial intelligence reshapes industries, economies, and daily life, society must grapple with fundamental questions about equity, responsibility, human connection, and the future of work. Through the lens of Vinyl Health, attendees will explore how AI can be used not to replace human relationships, but to strengthen them, helping people better understand their health, navigate complexity, and stay connected to the families, caregivers, and clinicians who support them.
