



FMEC Announces Plenary Speakers for 2024 Annual Meeting

DAYTON, OHIO – The Family Medicine Education Consortium (FMEC) will hold its <u>2024 Annual Meeting</u> at the Philadelphia Marriott in Philadelphia, PA from September 19-21, 2024. Plenary speakers will include Dr. Margot Savoy, Jim Zervanos and Dr. Nik Zervanos, and Dr. Anita Ravi, who will show the power and breadth of family medicine and educate and enlighten the audience about critical and emerging issues for primary healthcare.

- On Friday afternoon, Margot L. Savoy, MD, MPH, FAAFP, FABC, CPE, CMQ, FAAPL will present "The Value Proposition for Physician Wellness in Family Medicine." Dr. Savoy is Senior Vice President of Education, Inclusiveness and Physician Well-Being for the American Academy of Family Physicians, Associate Professor of Family and Community Medicine and Urban Bioethics and Population Health at the Lewis Katz School of Medicine, and Associate Professor (adj) at the Maurice Kornberg School of Dentistry at Temple University. Dr. Savoy's talk is sponsored by FMEC Platinum Partner, UPMC Life Changing Medicine.
- On Friday evening, Jim Zervanos will present "Five Lessons From a Patient on Matters of Life and Death." Jim is the author of two memoirs, That Time I Got Cancer: A Love Story and Your Story Starts Here: A Year on the Brink with Generation Z, and two novels, LOVE Park and American Gyro (2025). His award-winning essays and short stories have been published in numerous literary journals, magazines, and anthologies. He will be joined by his father, Dr. Nik Zervanos, and FMEC founder and founding Program Director of the Family and Community Medicine Residency Program at Lancaster (PA) General Hospital.
- On Saturday afternoon, **Anita Ravi, MD, MPH, MSHP, FAAFP** will present "The Art of 'Unlearning' to Advance Health Equity: The PurpLE Health Story." Dr. Ravi is CEO and Co-Founder of the PurpLE Health



Foundation, a nationally recognized non-profit pioneering the United States' first Center of Healthcare Excellence for Survivors of Gender-Based Violence to improve care for women, girls, and gender-diverse people who have experienced human trafficking, domestic violence, and sexual assault. Dr. Ravi is also a 2016 recipient of the FMEC's Emerging Leader Award.

The FMEC Annual Meeting, held every fall, attracts about 1,000 medical students, family medicine residents and faculty from the FMEC's 14 state + DC region in the northeast U.S. The meeting theme is "We've got HEART! We've got GRIT! We are FAMILY MEDICINE!." The headquarters hotel and meeting location is the Philadelphia Marriott (1200 Filbert Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107). See

The meeting features hundreds of educational sessions and a residency program recruitment fair of nearly 100 programs. Through a robust scholarship initiative, the FMEC is able to bring 300 medical students to the Annual Meeting to consider family medicine for their careers and to meet with residency programs.
